# Positive Behavior Support Initiative at RCIS

## Purpose of PBSI

The purpose of the Royse City Intermediate School Positive Behavior Support Initiative is to establish and maintain a safe and effective school environment that maximizes the academic and behavioral competence of all our students. The intermediate school staff, working with the Region 10 Education Service Center, is undertaking a three-year program of establishing PBSI at the Intermediate School. The first year will concentrate on the common areas within the school, such as the cafeteria, hallways, restrooms, locker areas, and bus areas.

## Major Components of PBSI

The major components of the PBSI Program are:

- Establishing a common approach to discipline building-wide.
- Positively-stated expectations for all students and staff.
- Procedures for teaching these expectations to students.
- Continuum of procedures for discouraging rule-violating behavior, and
- Procedures for monitoring and evaluating the effectiveness of the discipline system on a regular and frequent basis.

School-wide PBSI is a broad range of systematic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes while preventing problem behaviors for all students.

One of the pieces of the PBSI Program was the establishment of our Guidelines for Success. The PBSI Committee developed five parts for our Guidelines: Be Prepared, Be Respectful, Have Integrity, Be Determined, Excel in Everything. Our staff will be working with all students to emphasize our Guidelines and assist students in becoming successful students during their formative years at Royse City Intermediate School. The Committee also established an RCIS Honor Code (please see the other side of this brochure) in an effort to constantly remind students of what their expectations should be for themselves as individuals and as a part of the RCIS family.
